Classes Offered, Entry Fees & Schedule of Events:

Reinsmanship Classes: Class Fee \$15. (ADS article 37). To be shown both ways of the ring. 75% on handling of the reins

and whip, control, posture, and overall appearance of the driver. 25% on the condition of harness and vehicle and neatness of attire. Ribbons 1st – 6th

Working Classes: Class Fee \$15 (ADS Article 36) To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot, working trot and Strong trot. May be asked to rein back and execute a figure eight or an appropriate test. To be judged primarily on suitability of the horse to provide a pleasant drive. 70% on performance, manners and way of going of the horse(s). 20% on the condition and fit of harness and vehicle, 10% on neatness of attire. Ribbons 1st – 6th.

Cones Classes: Class Fee \$20. Helmets will be required. Course of 19 – 20 numbered cones, negotiated in order for time. Ribbons 1st – 6th. Gift Certificates for 1st Place.

\$100 Farm Credit Timed Obstacle Course: Course Fee \$25. Helmets will be required. Navigators required for horses, ponies and pairs. Participant will enter ring at a walk and proceed through timers to Obstacle 1, then complete a 10 -12 gate cones course and proceed through Obstacle 2 and exit through timers. Must exit the ring at a walk. Prize Money to be awarded: Ribbons 1st – 6th. Prize money awards \$50 for first, \$30 for second, \$20 for third.

PRESENTATION OF DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS

GENERAL RULES, INFORMATION, DIRECTIONS AND ACCOMODATIONS

Classes in general will follow the spirit of the ADS rules

Leaving horses unattended while put-to a vehicle, or removing bridle, or detaching the reins from bridle before unhitching is prohibited. Failure to comply will result in instant elimination without refund.

Junior competitors under the age of 14, must be accompanied by a competent adult at all times.

Management has the right to cancel any classes with less than two entries. Classes may be split or combined at the discretion of the organizers. Classes may be added to accommodate entries. Management has the right to cancel show for lack of entries.

Full turnout is optional, gloves and aprons recommended. Helmets are required for all timed classes (cones and obstacles) An appropriate driving whip shall be carried in hand at all times while driving.

All animals must be serviceably sound.

All dogs must be leashed

It is the competitors' responsibility to assure that harness is in good repair and the vehicle in sound condition. Any questions or disputes will be addressed by the Judge.

Any reckless driving that endangers oneself or fellow competitors will result in elimination. Overuse of the whip will be penalized.

A pleasure Spares Kit should be carried in your carriage at all times.

Golf Carts and Bicycles are permitted. Bring chairs and shade tents.

OVERNIGHT STABLING

All exhibitors who will require Friday night stabling, will be using the permanent stables on the west end of the show grounds. There will BE NO DRIVING ON FRIDAY NIGHT, and all carriages and harnessing will be done near the Grand Hunter Ring and in designated areas only. Please do not hitch carriages to horses/ponies near the stabling area as a hunter/jumper show will also be running simultaneously to this driving show. On Saturday morning, your equipment and trailer should be moved to the East Grounds and all hitching will be done there. ALL STALLS NEED TO BE RESERVED AND PAID FOR IN ADVANCE.

DIRECTIONS:

Take the Florida Turnpike to Exit #93, Lake Worth Road. After Toll Booth, make a Right (West) crossing over State Rd.#7/Highway 441 and continue 5 miles to South Shore Blvd. where Lake Worth Road ends. Make a Right, go to first light and turn left on Pierson Road. The First Left after that will be the entrance to the Show Grounds – The Fourth Left will be the entrance for stabling. Look for signs.

FROM THE WEST get to Southern Boulevard heading East. Once in Wellington area look for Big Blue Trace, make a right and take this road to South Shore Blvd. Make a right. Go to Pierson Road and make a right. The first Left will be the entrance to the Show Grounds. Parking on the Left, Show Grounds on the right.
