If you would like to volunteer for a half day, day or all three days, please complete the following information. All volunteers are admitted free for the day of service. You will receive a 2010 Carriage Affaire pin and program in appreciation of your services. Food vendors will be on site and you may purchase dinner tickets if you choose. Friday nights Dogs & Suds is \$10.00, Saturday's dinner catered by TooJay's is \$20. Advance reservations required.

Volunteers are needed for the following assignments:

Hospitality – Deliver snacks and drinks to the clinicians while they are giving lessons. One person needed each day.

Registration – We need several volunteers to check-in participants on Friday & Saturday, register day-auditors, and answer lots of questions! This is the hub of **the workshop** staff very active and lots of fun! Two persons needed each day

Membership – **The workshop** attracts lots of auditors who are not yet members but would like to join. Volunteers are needed on to provide membership applications and information and take in applications and dues. Two persons needed each day.

Safety – We will be requiring everyone who drives to first attend a safety check. We need several experienced drivers to staff the Safety Check point.

General – If you don't know what you would like to do – we need you! There will be many activities that require attention during **the workshop**. We may need you to check arm bands for admittance into the lectures, introduce the speakers, or help with one of the other volunteer jobs.
