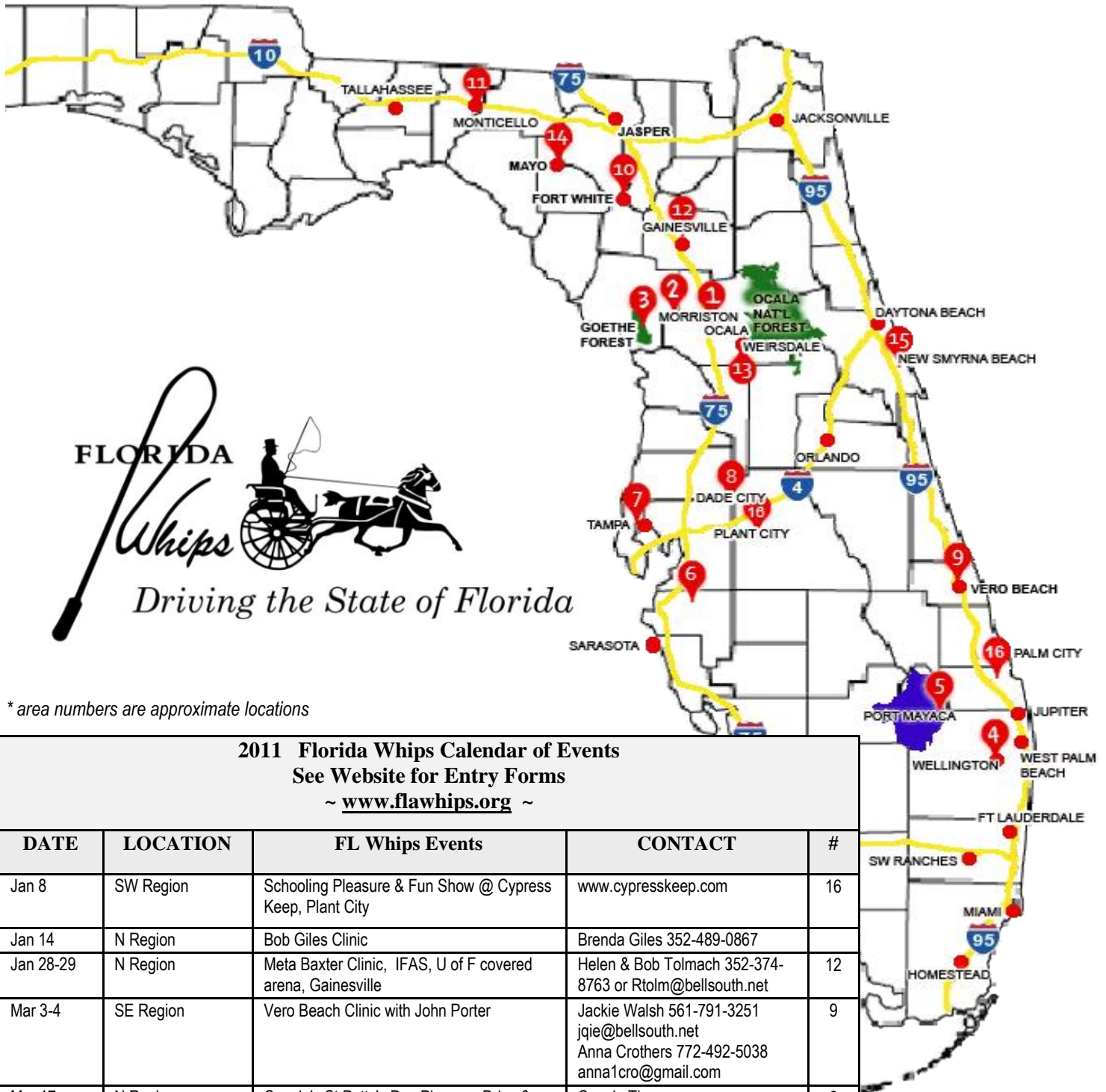

**HOLIDAY HORSE FEST
EQUESTRIAN SPORTS PRODUCTIONS
DOWNTOWN WPB EXHIBITION DERBY
DECEMBER 12, 2011**

From where I was sitting, I believe the exhibition was well received. The producers, ESP, myself, our volunteers and drivers all had a blast figuring out how the heck we were going to build a course, walk it and be in the ring in 15 minutes flat; somehow it got accomplished. The Derby was the final act, following the 2 jumper competitions, a dressage performance, jugglers, and a vaulting act. The horses and ponies were all cool and extremely well behaved as they milled around a very small schooling area and walked along the closed Flagler Boulevard, among high rises, traffic, restaurants, and curious spectators. The crowd was pretty large 3000 +/- is my guess and while the bleachers filtered out a bit as the day wore on, we had a very enthusiastic crowd.

The West Palm Beach Meyer Amphitheatre was tight putting in the 17 obstacle course that Barry Hunter had designed for us. We shortened it up a bit and our drivers, who had studied one course, had to quickly learn another. The portable obstacles that ESP and Jan and Sali Petri built for us looked AWESOME.
