SAT., APRIL 14, 2018 | VERO BEACH, FLORIDA

Please note location change from Wickham Park in Melbourne to Whispering Pines Equestrian Facility in Vero Beach

Do you have a horse you're starting to train to drive? Do you have a horse you already drive who is over-reactive to certain situations?

At this clinic, you will be working with your horse **<u>in-hand</u>** around various obstacles and challenges to improve your communication and their positive response to different stimuli.

- The morning 2 hour session will have you working your horse in your rope halter/lead.
- There will be a 1 hour lunch break (lunch is included in the registration fee)
- The afternoon 2 hour session will build on the morning's lessons. You may be able to work your horse in your blinker bridle and harness (ground driving), or continue working in-hand with your rope halter/lead.

PLEASE NOTE: This is <u>not</u> a "teach your horse to drive" clinic and your horse will <u>not</u> be hooked to a cart at this event.

ABOUT THE CLINICIAN:

Sarah Schlaich is the instructor and trainer at Whispering Pines Equestrian Facility, which focuses on teaching basic horsemanship to children and adults. She rides and trains Western and has been riding for almost 20 years. Sarah loves to compete in various types of events such as obstacle challenges, barrel racing and Extreme Cowboy Association races. She teaches people of all ages to communicate with horses, to get a desired response and to use positive reinforcement methods to earn respect. Sarah practices natural horsemanship methods working toward a positive response and goal achievement while building a partnership between horse and owner.



Welcome to the 2018 STRIDE Schooling Show Series! This information packet includes show information, directions to both show facilities, class information, "How to Win a STRIDE Year End Award," and a standard entry form to be used for all STRIDE shows. Volunteers Needed: STRIDE is a volunteer organization and depends on club members to help support its activities. Volunteers are rewarded with vouchers that can be used for entry fees, membership fees, shirts or any fee associated with a STRIDE event. Typical volunteer jobs are show manager, scribe, scorer, test runner, timer, ring steward, set up or take down of arenas and cones, etc. **One day of volunteering earns one voucher, equivalent to \$20**. Vouchers may be earned and used, or earned and gifted. Frequent volunteers are also recognized and rewarded at the year-end banquet. IMPORTANT – ASTM/SEI approved protective headgear mandatory at all times on show grounds when mounted or driving (including Western Dressage and Trails classes). "From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI(Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. 
