The Bridle-less Horse Notes on Safety and Safe Driving

Nothing will make your heart go "flitter-flutter" like seeing your bridle slide off the nose of your equine friend. We all know what is going to happen next as the pony/horse gets to see the nightmare (carriage) we have attached to their derriere! No, I don't want to hear about training and driving without blinkers. All of the harness makers across Europe, America and thru the centuries wouldn't have made blinkers if we didn't need them. The horses must learn to trust us as drivers.

The Amish and the draft horse people solved their problem with a side or overcheck. I shudder when I look at the pictures of old and the cruelty we inflicted on the horses with overchecks being too tight – all for the eye and image of a human. As drivers, we are much more humane today where we teach them to carry their own head and use their body efficiently.

The problem of losing a bridle comes into play if you don't cut a bridle path, if you have a horse or pony with small ears, or if you are hitching multiples where they can rub their heads together.

For the multiples I highly suggest a gullet strap (connect the throat latch to the nose band). For all equines with small ears – I suggest tying a string to the top of the bridle and braid the string into the first 1 inch of mane. You can unbraid it at the end of

your drive or use the knife that you always carry with you when you drive.

Keep your traces tight!

Oh hey, everyone... It's still hot really in case you relocate to an ice planet during the summer and wondered how things are down here... and I still have one more ridden dressage show/test to go. My enthusiasm levels are off the charts, if by "off the charts" you mean so low they fell BELOW the charts!

But there is a light at the end of the tunnel, Kentucky Classic is about 5 weeks away and I started mixing it up between driving and riding a few weeks ago. I feel for Xander during this time of year. Hopefully once we get past KY Classic I can add in a few trail rides (assuming Fall makes an appearance this year).

I know some people that were disappointed that KY went to short format, and I am torn between feeling that way, but mostly grateful that I have a really nice venue to start out our season with a short format more suitable to our readiness in Fall. It will also be the first show in the brand spankin' new presentation carriage, so here's hoping we don't go bowling



when we hit the cones course. I'm not going to lie, the times I practiced over the summer it was a bloodbath from the perspective of the cones. I love how the new carriage drives, but it drives a lot different than my marathon carriage and apparently Xander is way better at multiple disciplines than his driver is at multiple carriages. Knock on wood, I seem to have figured it out (mostly) in the last week or so.

Meet Your New Southwest Regional Director, Janet Hamilton



THE FLORIDA WHIPS HAS A NEW RECOGNITION PROGRAM

We are excited to announce the launch of the new Florida Whips Recognition Program!! The intent of this program is to encourage the active participation of our members in the various activities which promote the sport of driving. It is designed to ensure every contributor to the success of our sport is eligible to earn recognition. Activities are grouped into four individual categories: The Navigator, The Whip, The Wheeler, and The Leader. Each season, members who complete each category's requirements will earn a corresponding pin recognizing their contributions.

Members who earn pins in multiple categories have the potential to earn the Single, Pair, Tandem, or Coach awards which include an embroidered hat (Single & Pair), polo shirt (Tandem), or driving apron (Coach) on which to display their pins. We even have a special category for Volunteers – without whom none of this would be possible.

While all Florida Whips members are eligible – members who wish to participate must submit a completed Event Recognition Form to: info.flawhips.gmail.com within 15 days of the completion of each qualified event. Submissions will be verified, approved, and logged. Participants may inquire about their program status at any time throughout the season.

As with any new program, there will likely be a few adjustments and enhancements needed along the way. The current list of Rules and Requirements along with the Event Recognition Form are below and available on our new website. Please check back periodically throughout the season – to stay informed of any additions or alterations.

We look forward to seeing each of you during the upcoming Florida driving season!

The Florida Whips Annual Recognition Program

Rules for Recognition

- 1. Participants must be a Florida Whips member before the date of the referenced event
- 2. All eligible activities must occur between September 1st, 2020 and April 30th, 2021.
- 3. Participants must complete and submit the Event Recognition Form (along with any documentation) within 15 Days of the completed event. Participants will be notified within 7 days of receipt of form (via email) if the form has been approved or requires additional documentation. Participants have 7 days to resubmit with any additional documentation required.
- 4. Documentation regarding each participants status will be will be available upon request.

<u>Awards</u>:

Individual Category Pin (Navigator, Whip, Wheeler, Leader) - Participants who complete the requirement of any category will receive a corresponding pin recognizing their contributions during the Driving Season.

Volunteer Award – Participants who complete 3 Full Days of Volunteering will receive a Florida Whips Volunteer T-shirt in addition to the Navigator Pin.

Singles & Pairs Pins - Participants who achieve Singles or Pair Status will receive their pins and a ball cap embroidered with the Florida Whips Logo, year, and either "Singles Award Recipient" or "Pairs Award Recipient".

Tandem Pin - Participants who achieve Tandem Status will receive their badges and an embroidered polo shirt with the Florida Whips Logo, year and "Tandem Award Recipient".

Coaching Pin - Participants who achieve Coaching status will receive a Driving Apron embroidered with the Florida Whips Logo, year, and "Coaching Award Recipient" on which to display their pins.
