FLORIDA WHIPS RULES OF THE ROAD:

- 1. Vehicle and harness must be in serviceable and in good repair
- 2. Horses must have bridles on with reins attached prior to hitching to a vehicle
- 3. Vehicles must be unhitched prior to removing reins and bridle
- 4. Never tie a horse or leave it unattended when hitched to a vehicle
- 5. Driver mush always have a whip an carry it while in motion
- 6. Never pass another carriage at a fast trot and never drive too close to another driver

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS:

Classes in general will follow the spirit of the ADS rules.

Leaving horses unattended while put-to a vehicle, or removing bridle, or detaching the reins from bridle before unhitching is prohibited. Failure to comply will result in instant elimination without refund.

Junior competitors under the age of 18 must wear a helmet, and those under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a competent adult at all times.

Organizer has the right to (1) cancel any division or classes with less than two entries; (2) split or combine divisions or classes; (3) Add classes to accommodate entries; and (4) has the right to cancel show for lack of entries.

Full turnout is optional, gloves and aprons recommended. Helmets are required for all timed classes (cones and obstacles). An appropriate driving whip shall be carried in hand at all times while driving. Marathon vehicles permitted for Pleasure Classes.

Pneumatic Wheels are permitted at the Organizer's discretion

It is the competitor's responsibility that all animals are serviceably sound and that harness is in good repair and the vehicle in sound condition. Any questions or disputes will be addressed by the Judge. The Judge's decision is final.

The consumption of Alcohol is not permitted at any Whips Events for insurance purposes.

All dogs must be leashed.

Any reckless driving that endangers oneself or fellow competitors will result in elimination.

Overuse of the whip will be penalized.
