



It is with this thriving driving community in mind, I must discuss a critical matter which threatens to undermine all we have achieved: the need for volunteers to fill leadership positions.

The volunteers who are elected to serve as the Board of Directors, Regional Directors, and Committee Chairs are responsible for the club administration. They work behind the scenes to support the Florida Whips membership by managing club finances and insurance, approving the proposed schedule of events, publishing the annual calendar and events flyer, maintaining the club website and newsletter, organizing educational clinics, managing the membership database, and communicating changes to with the membership base.



Bo President's Message

Each position requires a commitment of approximately 12 hours per month. Volunteers serve a two-year term, and each position has a two-term limit.

There are **nine open volunteer positions** for the 2022 Florida Whips election year:

President – Presides over BOD meetings, manages feedback from the membership, resolves disputes.

Vice President – Schedules BOD meetings, ensures compliance with all by-laws, and acts as interim President in the event the President is unable to perform his/her duties.

Membership Director - Maintains membership database and mails welcome packets/calendar/flier to membership.

Southeast Regional Director - Organizes events for the Southeast Region.

Southwest Regional Director - Organizes events for the Southwest Region.

Youth Director - Promotes driving sport to those under 18 years of age.

Marketing Chair - Creates Florida Whips Calendar, The Events Flyer, secures advertising in Driving Digest, The Whip.

Newsletter Editor - Writes articles, gathers content, creates, and emails a Monthly/Bi-Monthly Newsletter.

Web Administrator - Updates Website with status of scheduled events, fliers, and registration forms and newsletter.

These volunteers are your fellow club members and competitors and frankly they're worn thin.

The Florida Whips plays a vital role in promoting the sport of driving by offering low cost events which welcome drivers of all experience levels. We offer the calendar, the website, and newsletter which create a sense of community among drivers supporting and motivating the development of all. We provide access to insurance for small venues which otherwise may be unable to host events. If we cannot fill these positions, there may be no alternative but to dissolve the club.

The club is at a critical juncture, and we need YOUR help. Together we can ensure the Florida Whips and the sport of driving thrive well into the future.

CARRIAGE DRIVING LESSONS WITH ELIZABETH KEATHLEY IN PALM BEACH COUNTY

Dianne Cohoon, a Whips member, had started all four juniors driving, as she has with many of the adult drivers in our area. She encouraged them to join the Florida Whips and to sign up for lessons with advanced instructors who are willing to come down to South Florida. The majority of the 17 lesson slots were filled by Dianne's students.

> At the request of the December students, by popular demand Elizabeth Keathley graciously agreed to return to Caloosa Equestrian Park in Palm Beach County, on March 12-13. 2022. Caloosa is a development at the very northern edge of Palm Beach County. However, attendees came from as far away as Miami.

> All four of the junior drivers were very apprehensive about having a lesson with Elizabeth in December, however, afterwards all four were very enthusiastic about having her come back for more lessons. This view was also shared by the adults.

> Florida Whips was very kind and gracious in again providing a grant that allowed the juniors to have lessons at half price. Surprisingly none of the junior's parents are "horse people." In fact, one mother told me she is afraid of horses and her daughter's pony.

> At the request of the parents, the juniors' names are being withheld. The youngest is 9, two are 12 and one is 16 years old. One parent relayed that her sweet child has dyslexia and since starting to drive last summer her reading ability has shown a remarkable steady improvement.
