FLORIDA WHIPS RULES OF THE ROAD:

1. Vehicle and harness must be in serviceable and in good repair
2. Horses must have bridles on with reins attached prior to hitching to a vehicle
3. Vehicles must be unhitched prior to removing reins and bridle
4. Never tie a horse or leave it unattended when hitched to a vehicle
5. Driver must always have a whip and carry it while in motion
6. Never pass another carriage at a fast trot and never drive too close to another driver

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS:

This is a schooling event, ADS rules will be followed in preparation for Recognized Shows

Leaving horses unattended while put-to a vehicle, or removing bridle, or detaching the reins from bridle before unhitching is prohibited. Failure to comply will result in instant elimination without refund.

Junior competitors under the age of 18, must be accompanied by a competent adult at all times and wear a helmet.

Full turnout is **recommended**. **There will be a presentation score.** Helmets are required **at all times by everyone in the carriage.** An appropriate driving whip shall be carried in hand at all times while driving.

Pneumatic Wheels are permitted

It is the competitor's responsibility that all animals are serviceably sound and that harness is in good repair and the vehicle in sound condition. Any questions or disputes will be addressed by the Judge. The Judge's decision is final.

The consumption of Alcohol is not permitted at any Whips Events for insurance purposes.

No dogs

Any reckless driving that endangers oneself or fellow competitors will result in elimination.

Overuse of the whip will be penalized.
